# Objective

## The courses

The integration courses are aimed at foreigners, late repatriates, asylum beneficiaries and refugees. In the courses the participants learn the German language and are made familiar with the living conditions in Germany.

The objective is for immigrants to be able to cope with their everyday lives without help. This is intended to improve the life prospects of the participants in Germany and their chances on the labour market.

The integration course contains a language course and an orientation course and includes 700 lessons in total.
